This is required under Money Laundering legislation and as a Garda organisation, we are particularly conscious that we need to be fully compliant with these regulations at all times. In 2017, over €1.5 million in cash prizes were won by members registered for the St. Raphael's Prize Draw. Every month, prizes totalling €35,000 are given away to members.
